

Reduce the proportion of domestic violence perpetrators reoffending by 25 per cent by 2019



81% of patients through emergency departments within four hours



Reduce overweight and obesity rates of children by 5% over 10 years



An 8% increase in the proportion of students in top two NAPLAN bands



Decrease the percentage of children and young people reported at risk of significant harm by 15%



Increase the proportion of young people who successfully move from Specialist Homelessness Services to long-term accommodation to more than 34%



Double the number of Aboriginal people in senior leadership roles and increase the proportion of women in senior leadership roles to 50% in the government sector in the next 10 years



Reduce the volume of litter by 40%




Deliver 61,000 housing completions on average per year to 2021
